**Reconfirmation Meeting for: March 2021**

<b>Reconfirm instructional delivery method:</b>
Primary face to face 5 days a week; Alternate virtual programming
<b>Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:</b>
Pre-Kindergarten: Direct instruction face to face, with optional packet learning for those that do not feel safe coming back to school.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Direct instruction face to face, with optional online learning for those that do not feel safe coming back to school.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Direct instruction face to face, with optional online learning for those that do not feel safe coming back to school.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Direct instruction face to face, with optional online learning for those that do not feel safe coming back to school.
<b>Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:</b>
